Be part of one of Williamsport's finest traditions—the 61st annual Way's Garden Art Show, held at Way's Garden, corner of Maynard and West Fourth Street in Williamsport.

Established in 1946, the Way's Garden show has provided an exhibition opportunity for artists from all over the county and beyond—all presented in a non-juried atmosphere. All art forms are welcome and are valued as an integral part of our rich artistic community. This show provides a great way to present your work, network with other artists, share your passion for art, and (hopefully) make a few sales, all on a Sunday afternoon in the park.

Since this event is held outdoors, be sure to bring everything you need to display and protect your work in the event of rain or wind. Bring as many pieces as you want that will fit into an approximate 10 x 10 space. Demonstrations are welcome and are sure to draw public attention. Remember, if you are going to set up a tent, a permit must be obtained from City Hall prior to the exhibit, and submit a copy with your application.

If a steady rain is forecast for the day, it is up to you to decide whether to participate. A decision will be made whether to move the show inside the YWCA.

NOTE: This has to be original artwork or prints from that artwork, and the artist must be present and has paid the application fee in order to display their own work.

Also, we do not allow a sales representative for a group of artists and we don't allow any commercial chain or store. Each individual who is displaying artwork, must pay the \$35 or \$60 (outside of fence) and be there and represent their own work.

All work must be hand made by the artist paying the entrance fee.

Note: Due to Way's Garden regulations, nothing may be sold within the Way's Garden fence: however, feel free to step outside of the fence to exchange money when you make a sale.

Please invite family and friends to enjoy a wonderful day at the show, and remember to take a break and visit the Strawberry Festival across the street at Trinity Episcopal Church.

June 5, 2017 - \$40 entry fee and Application **due** to ensure name is printed in the program. No fee charged for *Paid 2016* BEAL members.

June 11, 2017 – Sunday

Registration and Setup: 8 a.m. - -11 a.m. There is a possibility that we may set up tents on Saturday evening. Contact Gretchen for more information.

Art Show hours: 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Take down and clear: 4 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Registration and Setup:

Register upon arrival: 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. at the Artist Registration table. Space is granted on a first come, first serve basis. You may set up and display within a 10 x 10 space in the **designated areas along the walk.** Stay on designated areas,

Liability & Insurance:

Bald Eagle Art league, WLAC, and the Way's Garden Commission assume no liability, stated or implied, for the artwork or crafts displayed in the show. You are expected to provide your own insurance.

Tents and canopies

All Tents and canopies must be white and meet the flame propagation criteria of NFPA 701, CPAI 84 and the California title 19-1237—found on the inside of the tent material. If you plan to use a tent or canopy, visit the City Hall Codes Department (in person or online) for a permit, Submit a copy of the permit with your Way's Garden Application. The Codes Dept. will be around to check on compliance. This is a non-juried event that is open to the public. Please choose work that is appropriate for public display. Due to Way's Garden regulations, nothing may be sold within the Way's Garden fence; however, feel free to step outside the fence to exchange money if you make a sale.

Tenth Annual Eve Archer Award

This annual event continues through the volunteering efforts of many artists and their families. One of the most important figures in the Ways Garden Art & Crafts Show was Eve Archer, whose efforts over the years are now celebrated by the Eve Archer Award. This prize is a public vote for the best in show. Please take moment and vote for your favorite piece of art. Drop ballots (in program) at registration table. Eve's vision of making this show "open to all artists" is a vision that we still share and value today.

Note: All artwork must be hand-made and original. The artist must be present and must have paid the entrance fee in order to display their OWN work. We do NOT allow a sales representative for a group of artists and we do not allow any commercial chain or store. Again, each individual who is displaying artwork must pay the entrance fee \$40 (inside the fence) or \$60 (outside of the fence) for their OWN artwork and prints of their artwork.
