Morning session: Begins with warm-up drawing in pencil (soft 6B) or charcoal. Followed by warm-up painting on small canvases (throw away). These “trys” are strictly meant to “warm up”. During this session Joanne will explain how to set up a “rainbow” palette.

Afternoon session: Begin large canvases. Joanne will have these pinned to the walls, ready to go. Or students may bring stretched canvases and work on their easels.

Critique: A glass of wine and words of guidance will cap the day!

Included will be a follow up critique by Joanne at a later date. Participating artists can bring their canvases from the workshop. Joanne, I understand, will encourage us to continue to work on these pieces. Her paintings develop with freedom to “let go” of efforts 1 2 3, and more. She continues to work the image layer upon layer, at times “saving” only a few square inches of her original composition. This is a chance for us to experiment with these ideas under Joanne's experience, talent and support.

* Once Joanne receives a check (must be in by October 24) the student is registered and a list of supplies to bring will be sent (Joanne will supply small and large canvases or you can bring your own). Or anyone can give the check to me, Maggie Kemmerer, or to Dave Becker (by October 24).
